## **Sir Veza's revs up Tucson Mall's dining venues with Tasty Treats & Daily Garage Sale Specials**

**TUCSON** (February 3, 2012) – Nearly two years after opening one of Tucson's first "gastropubs," Ray Flores has done it again! Expanding on the popular garage-theme concept, the second Sir Veza's opened its (garage) doors this week at Tucson Mall.

"I wanted this location to really have a garage feel – which is why the ceiling has that un-finished industrial look and the lights and fixtures are painted to look rusted, like this place has been here for years," explained Flores. "In the car world, there is a phrase used to describe cars as 'built vs. bought' – that's what I had in mind when designing this location," said Flores.

Other interesting features that give the 6,000 square-foot space its "built" charm are the glass garage door windows that open up the indoor/outdoor bar and the full garage door window that opens the restaurant up to the street-side patio. Oh, and don't forget the diamond-plated chrome, 27 high-definition flat screen televisions and unique art hand-painted by Johnny Vegas.

From the popular SIRnoran hot dog to the tricked out tacos, Sir Veza's [menu](#), designed by celebrated mother, chef and author, Carlotta Flores, has a premium mix of traditional and unique flavors that will rev up any engine. Diners can watch as fresh salsa is made at the "chopper bar," located in the center of the restaurant.

The indoor/outdoor bar is complete with glass garage doors opening up to the patio, thirty beers on draft, including local brews from Nimbus and Barrio, as well as unique cocktails making Sir Veza's the unofficial "Day Drinking Headquarters." Daily garage sales, or happy hours, are from 3-6 and 9-close, seven days a week with a special bloody mary bar offered on Sundays.

For private parties, the Low Rider Lounge is the place to be, accommodating groups of up to 30 people. Inspired by [Gypsy Rose](#), an award winning 1964 Chevy Impala owned by Jesse Valadez, admired for its elaborate floral paint job and hot pink upholstery and known in the world of cruising lowriders as one of the most tricked-out muscle cars of its generation, the Low Rider Lounge at Sir Veza's is one-of-a-kind.

“We are delighted to have a locally-owned restaurant on property, especially one with such a commitment to the community,” said Tucson Mall’s General Manager, Jeff Berger.

During opening week, Sir Veza’s at Tucson Mall is proudly supporting two local non-profit organizations with a portion of opening-day proceeds benefiting the Boys and Girls Club of Tucson and on February 5, a portion of Super Bowl Sunday profits will benefit El Rio Foundation. Guests are invited to eat, drink, and support these two organizations in celebration of the second Sir Veza’s launch.
